The NRCS Web Soil Survey is the easiest portal to access detail information about soils in Delaware County and almost all of the United States. With a few simple steps, you can have access to detailed soils mapping and interpretive information that will assist you in management decision-making.

**ACCESSING THE WEB SOIL SURVEY** is as simple as typing the address above or using Google or other web search engines to find "NRCS Web Soil Survey." This will open the main page which has a lot of information on how to use the Web Soil Survey including detailed instructions.




Click on this button found on the home page to launch the Web Soil Survey.

There are 4 basic steps to using the Web Soil Survey: **1. Define** your Area of Interest (AOI), **2. View** the Soil Map, **3. Explore** the available data, **4. Check out** by printing your maps & reports (No Cost).

Defining your **AOI** may seem difficult at first but is actually very easy. The Web Soil Survey gives you a few different tools to do so including **Zoom and Pan** options as well as **Quick Navigation Search Options**.



Once you are zoomed in to your AOI, you define it clicking either of these buttons and then drawing it

Once your AOI is defined, you can View the soil map, see a breakdown of all soils found within the AOI, access the reports and print any of the data.
