## Annual Tree Sale

**Download our order form** for our annual tree sale. Orders are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Seedlings are bare rootstock, dipped in a preservative gel, and placed in a plastic bag. Seedlings should be planted as soon as possible and should be watered regularly for viability. Trees will be available for pick up at the office Wednesday, April 14th through Friday, April 16th from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. For after-hours pickup, please call the office to make arrangements. When picking up trees, please pull down to the lower level parking lot, and someone will be available to hand your order to you. There will be no need to get out of your car or enter the office.
