2019 saw great effort by Delaware SWCD staff members, as captured in our “By the Numbers” graphic.

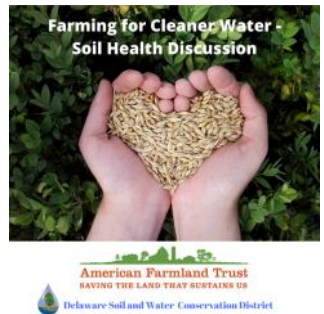
Farmland Preservation
